Goals of the conference

- The conference is dedicated to the 80th anniversary of the foundation of the Rivne State University of Humanities and the 20th anniversary of the scientific and educational activities of the Department of Ecology, Geography and Tourism;
- complex geo-ecological analysis of the current state of the environment of Ukrainian regions and neighboring countries;
- forecasting trends in the development of geosystems (ecosystems) under natural and anthropogenic transformations;
- development of promising directions for ensuring environmental safety and achieving a balanced use of nature;
- exchange of experience according to the new methods and technologies in the study of geosystems (ecosystems) and elaboration of proposals for solving actual geo-ecological problems;
- establishing creative connections between the participants of the conference for the purpose of the further development mutually beneficial cooperation on issues that are included into the scientific interest of the conference.

Scientific directions of the conference

1. Theoretical and methodological problems of geo-ecological research in the conditions of sustainable development.
2. Landscape approaches in regional geo-ecological studies.
3. Demographic and recreational problems in conditions of sustainable development of regions.
4. Geo-ecological status, cartographic modeling, forecasting and rational use of the natural-resource potential of regions (local territories).
5. Regional geo-ecological problems of river and lake basin systems.
6. Geo-ecological monitoring. Information systems and technologies in geo-ecological research.
7. Geo-ecological problems of waste management, its utilization and processing.
8. Geo-ecological problems in the agricultural sphere.
9. Geo-ecology of residential geosystems (ecosystems).
10. Ecological network and conservation as part of a regional strategy for the conservation and reproduction of biodiversity and landscape diversity.
11. Global and regional climate change and geo-environmental issues related to them.
12. Conceptual principles for sustainable development of united territorial communities
13. Socio-ecological, ecological-ethical and pedagogical problems in ecological education, culture and education.

Conditions for participation in the conference and publication of materials

1. Form of participation in the conference: **full-time / part-time**.
2. The application for participation in the conference, the materials of the report, the scanned copy of the receipt for payment of the application fee should be sent electronically no later than **30.06.2020** to the following e-mail: conf.geoecology2030@gmail.com
3. Working languages of the conference – Ukrainian, English, Polish, Russian.

Details for payment of the organizational fee

The cost of full-time participation in the conference is 300 UAH for participants from Ukraine and 15\$* for foreign participants. The cost of part-time participation in the conference is set at 60.00 UAH (for Ukrainian and foreign participants) per page of submitted text (minimum volume – 3 pages). The conference collection of materials will be forwarded at the expense of the recipients.

Foreign participants who will attend the conference full-time will be able to pay the registration fee directly during registration. Forwarding of conference materials for foreign participants, who will participate the conference part-time will take place only in electronic format.

*Equivalent in UAH at the date of dispatch of materials up to **30.06.2020**

*Participants of the conference, who will personally take part in the conference on **22-24.09.2020**, will be able to take part in a friendly dinner, ecological study and other scientific and cultural events.*

Costs related to business trip, accommodation, friendly dinner, excursions are not included in the participation fee and are paid separately by the conference participants.

Requirements for the design of materials

Text editor – Microsoft Word (2003/2007/2010 version).

Volume of materials – 3-5 full pages of A5 format, orientation – portrait.

Font: headset – Times New Roman, size – 10, line spacing – 1.0.

All fields – 15 mm. Paragraph indentation is 5 mm.

References to sources in the text are given in square brackets: the first number is the number of the source in the list, followed by the page number [1, p. 5]. The list of sources is printed alphabetically at the end of the text.

Text layout: 1) UDC (left); 2) the initials and surnames of the author (s), academic degree, academic title, position, place of work or study (right); 3) at intervals below, in the middle of the title, in boldface capital letters; 4) at the interval below, the abstract text (3–5 sentences) and keywords (3–5 words) in the language of the article; 5) at intervals the text of the article; 6) at intervals below the list of sources.

The submitted materials should cover the statement of the problem in general form and its connection with important scientific and practical tasks; analysis of recent research and publications in which the problem is solved and referred to by the author, the selection of previously unsolved parts of the general problem to which the article is devoted, research methodology, formulation of the goals of the article (tasks), presentation of the main research material, comparison of the results obtained with the results of other scientists, conclusions and prospects for further work on this issue.

Before the recommendation for printing, materials will be checked for plagiarism. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject materials that do not correspond to the subject matter of the conference in content or are issued without complying with the specified requirements.
